

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) FOR WEBSITE REDESIGN

Introduction

The Organization of Caribbean Utility Regulators (OOCUR) invites qualified web design and development firms to submit proposals for the complete redesign of its website. The goal is to create a modern, user-friendly, and accessible website that effectively communicates OOCUR's mission, services, and resources while incorporating best practices in web design and functionality.

Background & Current Website Limitations

OOCUR's current website serves as a primary information hub for regulators, industry stakeholders, and the public. However, it faces several challenges, including:

- Outdated design and user interface.
- Difficult navigation and content discoverability.
- Limited content management capabilities, requiring technical expertise for updates.

Project Objectives

The redesigned website should:

- Clearly communicate OOCUR's vision and mission.
- Represent the diverse organisations served by OOCUR.
- Improve user experience and accessibility.
- Be visually appealing, mobile-friendly and responsive across all devices and web browsers.

- Provide easy navigation, intuitive site architecture and a capacity for evolving adaptability.
- Enhance content management capabilities through a robust CMS.
- Integrate interactive features, including event calendars and social media feeds.
- Ensure compliance with security and data privacy best practices.
- Incorporate SEO best practices and analytics tools for performance tracking.
- Support multilingual content (English, Spanish, French, Portuguese and Dutch preferred).

Scope of Work

The selected vendor will be responsible for:

Website Design & Development

- Creating a custom, visually engaging design aligned with OOCUR's branding.
- Implementing a mobile-responsive layout.
- Developing a structured information architecture for easy navigation.
- Designing templates for key pages, including Homepage, About Us, Events, Publications, Membership, Contact Us, and News.
- Ensuring accessibility compliance (WCAG 2.1 or higher).

Content Management System (CMS)

- Recommending and implementing a user-friendly CMS (WordPress, Drupal, or equivalent).
- Providing content migration from the existing website.
- Enabling OOCUR staff to update content with minimal technical expertise.

Features & Functionality

- Searchable document repository for reports, publications, and regulations.
- Membership portal with login for access to restricted resources.
- Event calendar with registration and scheduling capabilities.

- Integration of social media platforms.
- News and announcement blog section.
- Contact forms and inquiry management system.

Security & Performance

- Implementation of SSL encryption and secure user authentication.
- Regular security updates and vulnerability scanning.
- Fast page load times and optimized performance.

Training & Support

- Training sessions for OOCUR staff on CMS management and content updates.
- Documentation and user manuals.
- Ongoing technical support and maintenance options.

Proposal Requirements

Interested firms must submit a proposal including:

- Company Background: Overview of the company, experience, and portfolio of relevant projects.
- **Project Approach & Methodology**: Description of the design and development process.
- **Technical Specifications**: Proposed CMS, hosting requirements, and security measures.
- Timelines, Milestones and Deliverables: Estimated schedule for project completion.
- **Budget & Cost Breakdown**: Detailed pricing structure.
- References: Contact details of previous clients for reference checks.

Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Demonstrated experience and expertise (30%)
- Quality of proposed design and user experience approach (25%)
- Technical feasibility and security measures (20%)
- Cost-effectiveness and value for money (15%)
- Proposed timeline and support options (10%)
